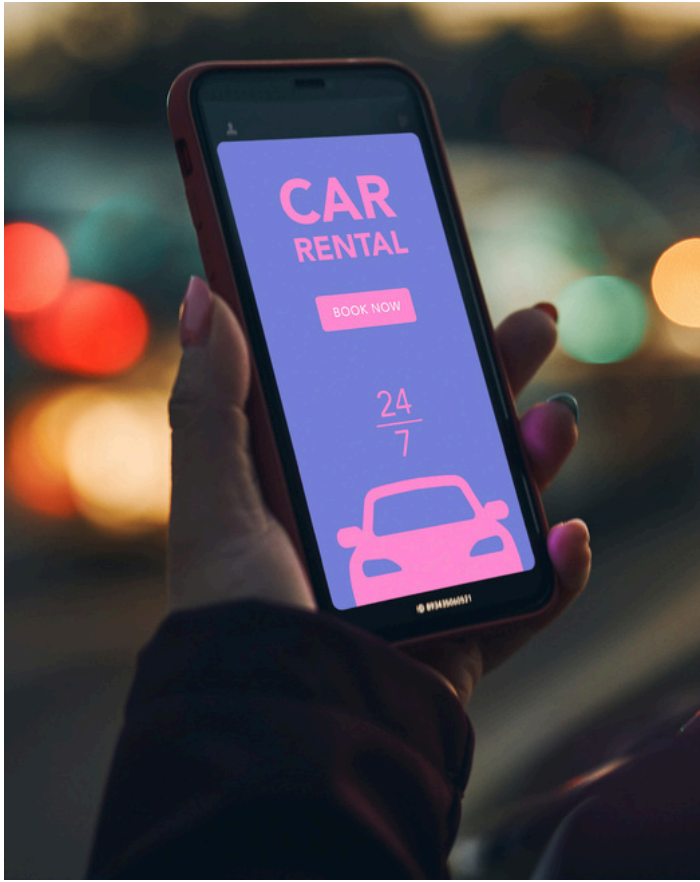

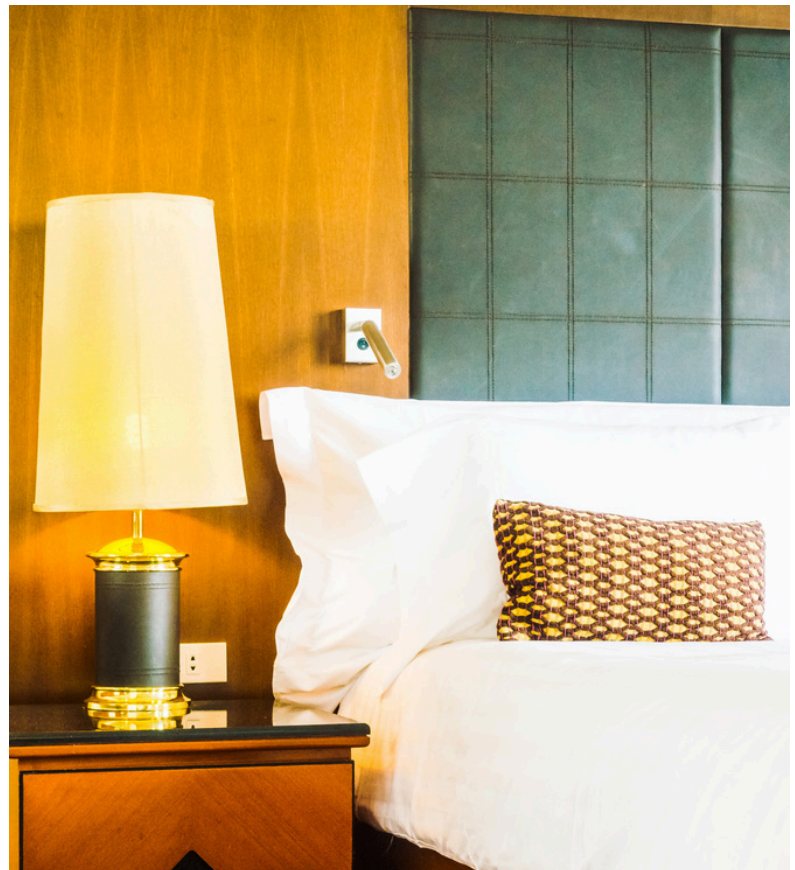
Commuting made Easy

The Bahrain Dinar

Bahrain uses the Dinar (BHD). ATMs are common for withdrawing cash with international cards (inform your bank!). Bargain in markets/unscheduled taxis, but not usually elsewhere. Tip 10-15% in restaurants; rounding up taxis is appreciated.

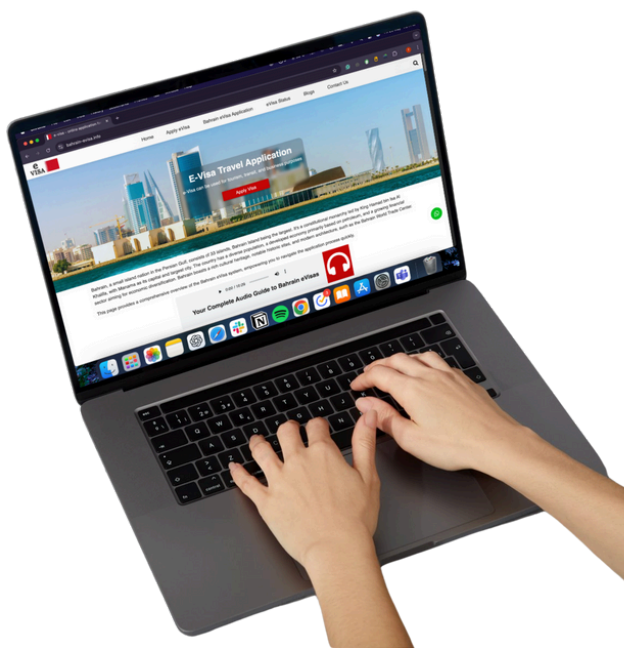
Staying Connected

Prepaid SIMs (BHD 2-5) with data plans from BHD 3 are easily found in Bahrain. eSIM is available for compatible devices via local and international (Airalo, Holafly, Nomad) providers. While free Wi-Fi exists in public areas, a local SIM or eSIM ensures more dependable internet access everywhere.

2. Pay eVisa Fee

3. Receive eVisa Electronically

Note: The eVisas are available as single- or multiple-entry permits, with a maximum validity of 90 days.

Sep-Nov

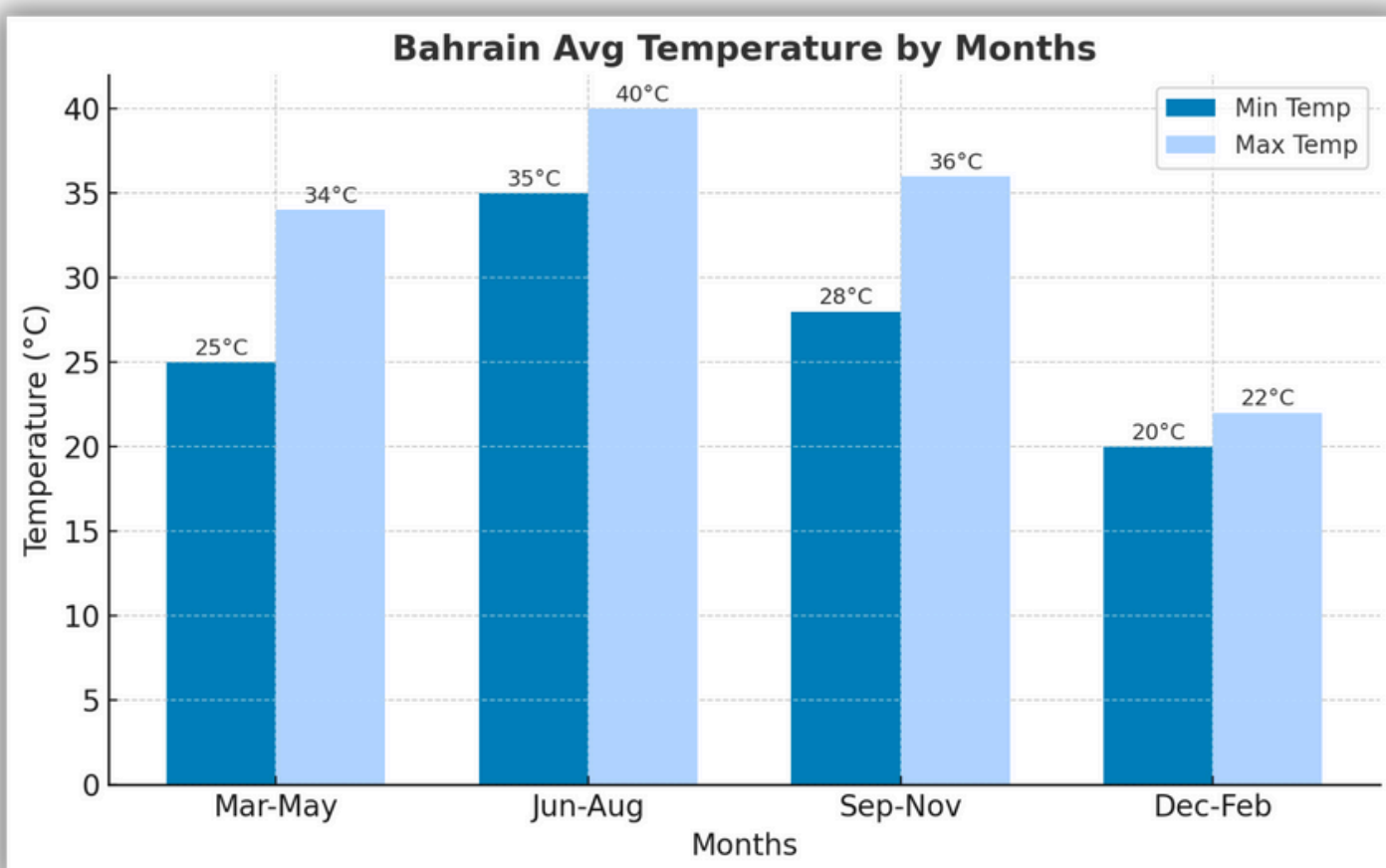
Autumn with Temperature ranging between **28-36 °C**
